Speaker Profiles

Samie Patnode is Policy Analyst for Oregon’s Board of Electrology and Body Art Practitioners, with 20 years’ experience in licensing and regulation for health-related professions, including electrology. She creates and implements policy guidelines-based administrative law, and facilitates changes to administrative rules, as well as other long term policy plans and outcomes. Recent administrative rule changes to the electrology program will be the topic of her presentation, including how to implement the changes in a practical work setting for electrology.

Margot Presley, FNP, DNP, MN-RN, BA, is a family nurse practitioner with the Multnomah County Public Health Department, providing primary care services predominantly to refugee and immigrant patient populations within the patient-centered primary care home model. Margot’s specialties include transgender health, substance use and general health.

Joanie Gonella, LE, CPE, has a Bachelor’s Degree in the field of Neuroscience from the University of California, Irvine, and a post-graduate certificate in Pre-Health sciences from Florida Atlantic University. She obtained her Electrology license in California in 2003, and became a certified permanent makeup technician in 2004. Today, Joanie is an internationally recognized speaker in the field of electrology and skin care, and is also an active member of the American Electrology Association.

Dr. Daniel Dugi is committed to treating all people with dignity and respect. He was co-founder of OHSU’s Transgender Health Program in 2012, where he provides gender-affirming care, including assistance with complications of genital surgery performed elsewhere. He has sought additional education and training for gender-affirming surgery, both in the United States and Europe, and his services currently include MtF vaginoplasty (SRS) and orchiectomy.

Dr. Paula Amato specializes in the science of caring for patients with infertility, polycystic ovary syndrome, and menopausal issues. Her research interests include stem cells, metabolic-endocrine interactions, and environmental impacts on reproductive health. Dr. Amato finds her work intellectually stimulating and highly rewarding. Her interest in the science of reproduction, as well as the opportunity for connecting with individuals and families, are what inspired her to pursue a career in reproductive endocrinology and infertility.
